HISTORY OF THE CLUB

As Supplied by Marie Westwood , President of Lockyer Valley on 1/12/2013

On Tuesday, June 17, 2008 at Gatton, the Rosewood Toastmasters held a demonstration Toastmasters meeting and a form to apply to organise a Toastmasters Club was distributed.

The following week on June 26 members of the Lockyer Valley community started a six week Speechcraft course which was well attended and finished on July 31.

August 7 saw the formation of a Toastmasters Club in the Lockyer Valley called *The Lockyer Valley Toastmasters Club*.

On Friday 15 August, the then District Governor, Lesley Storkey, presented the Lockyer Valley Toastmasters Charter papers up on stage at the Toastmasters International Convention in America to form the first new Toastmasters Club in the world for the Toastmasters 2008/2009 year.

The club was officially chartered on September 1st, 2008.

Records confirm that there was a Toastmasters Club in Gatton from August 1983 to April 1996. Four original members of this club attended the charter dinner. They were Eric and Valerie Halmer and Barry and Eileen Prior.

May we all live in harmony for the betterment of Toastmasters.

We are pleased you have made the commitment to attend a meeting of the Lockyer Valley Toastmasters Club. We hope you will be one of the team players and that you will be happy in our club environment. Let us all remember the Club Promise and keep the club healthy and the spirit alive.

A Brief History of Toastmasters in the Mackay Region LYNNE O'NEILL

This evening we are celebrating the establishment of District 69 fifty years ago in 1971.

However, Toastmasters was already active in Mackay at that time. Coolabah Toastmaster Club was chartered in Mackay in 1961 and was the second Toastmaster club in Queensland. This followed only four years after the first Toastmaster club in Australia, Wollongong, was chartered in 1957.

As with all Toastmasters clubs in those days, the Coolabah Club was men only. The first mixed Toastmasters club, Mackay Club, was chartered in 1977. Coolabah Club closed in 1984.

Other Toastmasters clubs followed: Pioneer in 1985, Eyeopener and Dysart in 1986. The Dysart club changed its name to Coalfields in 1994 and then in 2002 became Calen Canefields. All these clubs are still active. The latest club is Mackay Regional Council Club which chartered this year.

There have been other Toastmasters clubs in the Mackay region: Gateway (which was in Sarina) 1981-2005, Pioneer Valley 1992-2008, Moranbah 1995-1999, Toast of the Town 1996-2005, CQU 1999-2008, Mackay City Council 2003-2005.

Several Mackay Toastmasters have filled the position of Northern Division Governor (now Director) and some have held other District Offices.

Dianne Riddell was District Governor in 1985/86. She was a charter member of Mackay, Pioneer and Eyeopener clubs.

Thank you for your letter of 5 October asking for information about the formation of our Club.

In early 2005 I began looking for a Toastmasters Club within the Brisbane CBD that met either during lunch hour or early after hours. The only clubs I could find were Corporate with restricted membership which got me wondering why Qld Rail (QR), with a staff of over 13,500, did not have a corporate club.

I asked the question and the response I received was "go and build one".

Since I wasn't even a Toastmaster my first important task was to join a suburban club so that I could get an understanding of how Toastmasters worked. I joined Riverside Club in Area 20 (Bulimba).

Shortly afterwards I contacted District 69 for information about building a corporate club and had email discussions with Trish Springsteen, Sandra Simpson and Bob Simpson who sent me a package on Building a Toastmasters Club.

I approached QR senior management and wrote a business case submitting it to the Executive General Manager of Human Resources who agreed to support the building of the club as part of their Leadership Initiative and promised funds to cover the cost involved.

Trish Springsteen also mentioned that there was at least one employee within QR who had a long time association with Toastmasters and she introduced me to Nev Heales who agreed it was a great idea and agreed to help organise the Demonstration Meeting.

The demo meeting was held on 2 November 2005 and we were able to get some senior managers to attend. From this meeting we very soon had enough members to form the club.

I have attached an information sheet on the club which sets out times/dates of meetings and club executive and mentors.
