All Area 26 clubs are working towards the educational points component of the DCP program, and this (plus helping with member growth strategies) will remain the focus for the Area 26 Director in the remaining months. Discussions are underway with several potential successors for the role of Area 26 Director, and the Area Director has expressed interest in applying for the role of District PRM in 2025-26.

### **Status of Eastern Division Formation & Growth**

Open to expressions of interest in forming new clubs. Demonstration meeting is being held 4-Apr-2025 12noon at the Cannon Hill School of Arts in April which is aiming to start a lunchtime club for the Southgate Business Park and Metroplex on Gateway (Murarrie) business hubs.

Bulimba Riverside Club has managed to increase their number base back up to 10. They have guests attending, which is promising.

Area 26 is seeing continued member growth, with 3 of the 5 clubs now at 20+ members, and total member growth of 11% (9 new members) since June 2024 - despite the Presidents of 2 of the clubs stepping down (and out of Toastmasters) in the first half of the year. The Area 26 Director has completed the second round of official club visits in the second half of the year.
